Learned counsel for the petitioners has contended that in compliance with the order dated 16.03.2020, the petitioners have since joined the investigation.

Ld. State counsel, on instructions from SI Deep Singh has conceded this fact, further stating that custodial interrogation of the petitioners is not required.

It being so, the interim bail granted to the petitioner, vide order dated 16.03.2020 is made absolute, subject to the following conditions:-

1. that the petitioners shall make themselves available for investigation by a police officer as and when required;
2. that they shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted

with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer and;

- 3. that they shall not leave India without prior permission of the Court.
- 4. that they shall surrender their passports before the Investigating Officer and if they are not having passports, then, shall file the affidavits in that regard.

In case, the petitioners violate any terms & conditions, on which the bail has been granted to them , the prosecution would be entitled to apply for cancellation of bail.

The petition stands allowed accordingly.
