Case is taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

There is no representation on behalf of the petitioner. Even on
28.07.2021, the situation remained the same.

By way of the present writ petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, the petitioner prays for issuance of a writ in the nature of Habeas Corpus to secure the release of his family members, as detailed in para No.1 of the petition, from the alleged illegal detention of respondent Nos. 5 and 6.

As detailed in para No.1 of the petition, the family members of the petitioner, have been illegally detained by respondent Nos. 5 and 6 and even the house of his family has also been illegally occupied by the said

respondents.

Vide order dated 12.03.2020 passed by this Court, the respondent-State was directed to file the status report regarding the illegal detention of the family members of the petitioner.

In compliance thereof, the reply by way of affidavit dated 07.08.2021 of the Deputy Commissioner of Police, Central, District Faridabad, already filed in the Registry, is taken on record.

Learned State counsel draws the attention of this Court to the affidavit (annexed as Annexure R.2 with the aforesaid reply) executed by petitioner-Farman Khan, deposing therein he does not want to pursue the present petition and wishes to withdraw the same. He further submits that in FIR No. 70 dated 04.03.2020, under Sections 363, 366-A and 368 IPC, at Police Station Kheripul, District Faridabad, registered on the complaint of respondent No. 5-Sunil Kumar Bhati against the petitioner, a cancellation report has been filed, as during the investigation, complainant-Sunil Kumar Bhati (father of Mansi) has stated that he has no objection to the marriage of his daughter-Mansi with Farman Khan (petitioner).

Though today there is no representation on behalf of the petitioner, yet in view of the fact that the petitioner does not want to pursue the present petition, the same is dismissed being infructuous.
