Petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.0039 dated 16.03.2021, under Section 306 of IPC, registered at Police Station City Fazilka, District Fazilka.

By virtue of the order dated 09.09.2021, while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation. It has been contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has joined the investigation and fully cooperated and thus, the interim order may kindly be made absolute.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Beant Singh has endorsed the same and submitted that petitioner is no more required for further investigation.

Learned counsel for the complainant vehemently opposes the contentions of learned counsel for the petitioner.

In view of the same, the interim order dated 09.09.2021, is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C. and the petition stands allowed.
