**GIRISH AGNIHOTRI, J. (Oral)**

Petitioner-Sanju alias Sagar Sharma, stated to be aged 27 years, has filed the present petition *inter alia* with a prayer for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondents No.1 to 3 to furnish Police Clearance Report to the petitioner in case FIR No.63 dated 17.06.2018, registered at Police Station Subhanpur, District Kapurthala, under Sections 323, 324, 341, 506 & 34 of Indian Penal Code, on the basis of cancellation report dated 17.08.2019 (Annexure P-4), submitted by the Police.

Learned counsel for the petitioner based on the pleadings in the petition, submits that the petitioner was falsely involved in the case FIR No.63 dated 17.06.2018 lodged under Sections 323, 324, 341, 506 & 34 of Indian Penal Code, at Police Station Subhanur, District Kapurthala. It is submitted that this FIR was allegedly filed on complaint made by Mewa

Singh. It is then submitted that on 21.06.2018, mother of the petitioner filed application before respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Kapurthala, for conducting fair and proper investigation from the higher officials in the said case. It was also rather alleged in the application of the mother of the petitioner that in fact, on account of political influence, her husband was badly beaten by one Amandeep Singh alias Nikku.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Pawan Sharda, Assistant AG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the State.

Learned counsel for the petitioner at this stage makes a request that for the same/similar grievance as made in the present writ petition, the petitioner has submitted a representation dated 02.02.2021 (Annexure P-5) which has not been decided till date.

Without commenting upon merits of the case, this Court deems it appropriate to dispose of the present writ petition with a direction to the Authority concerned/respondent No.2, to decide the representation dated 02.02.2021 (Annexure P-5) in accordance with law as expeditiously as possible, preferably within a period of one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

Ordered accordingly.
