This criminal writ petition has been filed under Article 226 Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus for directing respondent Nos.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners, who are apprehending threats at the hands of respondent Nos.4 to 8.

On 12.03.2020, the following order was passed by this Court:

“Ms. Monika Jalota, DAG, Punjab is directed to find out the existence of alleged threat. Counsel for the petitioners undertakes to supply three sets of paper book to the learned State counsel, during the course of the day.”

Learned State counsel has produced the statements of the petitioners and stated that as on today, they are not facing any threat and do not need any protection.

Today, no one has appeared on behalf of the petitioners.

Considering the above statements of the petitioners, nothing survives for adjudication in this petition.

Dismissed as infructuous.
