A Coordinate Bench of this Court had passed the following order  
on 08.04.2021:-

“Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 30 dated 17.01.2021 under Section 18 & 61 of NDPS Act of 1985 (Section 27(A) added lateron) registered at P.S.City Fatehabad, District Fatehabad.

As per allegations in the FIR, 1 Kilogram 250 grams of opium was recovered from co-accused Pardeep Kumar and Jai Parkash alias Jassi. The name of the petitioner is alleged to have figured in the statement of coaccused wherein they stated that the petitioner had supplied the contraband to them for a sum of Rs. 1,20,000/-.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner has falsely been implicated only on the basis of disclosure statements having been suffered by the co-accused. There is no other criminal case registered against the petitioner.

Notice of motion for 19.05.2021.

Meanwhile, in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on interim anticipatory bail to the satisfaction of the Arresting/Investigating Officer, subject to the conditions provided

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under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C. The petitioner is also directed to join the investigation and cooperate with the Investigating Agency, as and when required.”

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from SI Sumer Singh, states that the petitioner has joined investigation and recovery of ₹5,000/- has been effected from him.

In view of the above and the petitioner having joined investigation, the Covid-19 Pandemic, the order dated 08.04.2021 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
