Today learned State counsel has produced the statements of the petitioners and stated that as on today, they are not facing any threat and do not need any protection.

In view of the statements of the petitioners, learned counsel for the petitioner does not press this petition and prays for withdrawal of the same.

The prayer is accepted.

The petition is dismissed as withdrawn.
