Petitioner, in the present writ petition, filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, is aggrieved against the non-grant of promotion to the post of Senior Assistant vide order dated 19.02.2021 (Annexure P-6) passed by the District & Sessions Judge, Faridabad.

Rule 14(B) of the Punjab Subordinate Courts Establishment (Recruitment & General Conditions of Service) Rules, 1997 provide for provision of an appeal to the member of the service against the order of substantive appointment by promotion or otherwise, to a permanent and pensionable post. Thus, in the considered opinion of this Court, the petitioner has an alternative and efficacious remedy of appeal.

Accordingly, in view of the above, the present writ petition is disposed of, with liberty to the petitioner to prefer a statutory appeal, within a period of 4 weeks from today.
