The present petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India with a prayer for quashing the transfer order dated 26.03.2021 (Annexure P-3) on the ground that the petitioner has been transferred second time after her joining at new station.

The learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner was transferred vide Annexure P-1 on 25.02.2021 from GMS Mian to Bathinda where she has joined and thereafter, vide impugned order dated 26.03.2021 (Annexure P-3), the petitioner was again transferred to Talwandi Sabo.

Mr. Pawan Sharda, learned Sr. DAG, Punjab has submitted that he has received an advance copy of the petition and he has instructions to say that the petitioner has been transferred vide Annexure P-3 in pursuance of the Policy of the Government, dated 17.03.2021, which came into force after Annexure P-1 dated 25.02.2021 and the

petitioner has been transferred in accordance with the policy and that the petitioner had not turned up for giving of her option.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that he may be permitted to withdraw the present petition so as to enable her to approach the competent authority by filing a representation regarding exercising of option.

Learned State counsel has submitted that the State has got no objection in case the petitioner files representation.

In case, such a representation is filed before the competent authority, the same shall be considered in accordance with law.

In view of the above, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn.

Needless to say that if any representation is filed by the petitioner before the competent authority then the same shall be decided disposed of in accordance with law within 2 weeks.
