This writ petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution for the issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to grant benefits of Assured Career Progression (ACP) to the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, on instructions, points out that relief claimed in the present petition has already been granted vide order dated 23.02.2021. Thus, the present writ petition is rendered infructuous.

Ordered accordingly.

It is, however, clarified that in case petitioner feels aggrieved against the aforesaid order dated 23.2.2021, he would be at liberty to avail remedy available to him, in accordance with law.
