Challenge in the present writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is to the impugned order dated 20.08.2019 (Annexure P-5) whereby the license of the petitioner under the Punjab Public Distribution System (Licensing and Control) Order, 2003 has been suspended w.e.f. 20.08.2019.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from the District Food Supplies Controller, Hoshiarpur, has stated that impugned order has since been withdrawn vide order dated 18.02.2021 by the District Food Supplies Controller, Hoshiarpur. She would further contend that the requisite amount required to be deposited by the petitioner has since been deposited and the supplies have been released to him.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, on the basis of the statement made by learned counsel for the State, does not wish to press the present writ petition as the same has been rendered infructuous.

Dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.
