Case has been taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing.

This Criminal Writ Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India has been moved by petitioners for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing respondents No.1 and 2 to protect the life and liberty of petitioners at the hands of private respondents and to take action on representations dated 12.12.2020, 15.12.2020 and 25.03.2021 (Annexures P-3, P-6 and P-8).

Learned counsel for the petitioners contended that petitioners have already made representations on 12.12.2020, 15.12.2020 and 25.03.2021 to Station House Officer, Police Station Ram Nagar, Karnal, Superintendent of Police, Karnal and Director General of Police, Panchkula (Haryana), copies of which are available on the file as Annexures P/3, P/6 and P/8, but still no action has been taken.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 and 2 only.

At the asking of Court, Mr. Vikrant Pamboo, Deputy Advocate General, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 and 2. Complete copy of paper book has been supplied to him.

In view of above, the present petition is disposed of with the direction to Superintendent of Police, Karnal, to look into and decide representation dated 25.03.2021 (Annexure P/8) in accordance with law by passing speaking order and that too within eight weeks positively from the date of receipt of copy of this order.
