This is a petition for regular bail filed on behalf of the petitioner under Section 439 Cr.P.C. in case FIR No.331 dated 05.10.2020, under Sections 379-A, 411 and 34 of the IPC, registered at Police Station Urban Estate, District Rohtak.

2. The petitioner has remained in detention for ten

months, since 22.11.2020.

3. The amount of Rs.1,500/- as Sale Proceeds for a snatched Gold Chain were allegedly recovered from him on the disclosure statement of co-accused Aditya and Sahil.

4. The trial is likely to take its own substantial time to complete, since not even the first witness, out of the total twenty prosecution witnesses, has yet been examined.

5. In the circumstances, without commenting any further on the merits of the present case as a whole and keeping in view the fact that further detention of the the petitioner for an indefinite period is not called for at this stage, his prayer for regular bail is allowed and he is ordered to be released on regular bail subject to appropriate terms and conditions to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court/Duty Magistrate, concerned.
