Prayer in the instant petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, is for issuance of directions to the official respondents to provide protection of life and liberty to the petitioners at the hands of private respondents.

At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners would be satisfied if a direction is issued to respondent No.2- Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana, Punjab to look into their representation dated 24.03.2021 (Annexure P-14).

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Sidakmeet Singh Sandhu, Assistant Advocate General, Punjab, who has joined the proceedings through video conferencing, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents-State.

This Court would refrain from commenting on the money transactions which allegedly have taken place between the petitioners and the private respondents, however, in view of the submissions made by the learned counsel for the petitioners that the private respondents have been

threatening them to be done to death, respondent No.2-Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana, District Ludhiana, Punjab is directed to look into the representation dated 24.03.2021 (Annexures P-14) of the petitioners *qua* the threat perception and take appropriate steps/action, if any required under the provisions of law.

The petition is disposed of accordingly.
