The matter has been taken up through video conferencing.

The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for the grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.48 dated 10.02.2021 registered under Section 323, 34, 365 IPC (Sections 148, 506, 149 IPC and Section 25 of Arms Act added later on), at Police Station Chandimandir, District Panchkula, Haryana.

The petitioner is being prosecuted for having kidnapped the complainant's husband and then giving him beatings as also getting a video made from him with regard to showing of co-accused Yadwinder Singh's company in good light.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case due to professional rivalry between the co-accused Yadwinder Singh and the complainant's husband; the petitioner has no other criminal case pending against him; the petitioner is not named in the FIR and that under the interim orders passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel submits that under the interim orders

passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation, cooperated with the same and that his custodial interrogation is not required.

After considering the totality of the above facts and in particular the statement made by learned State counsel that under the interim orders passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined investigation; cooperated with the same and that his custodial interrogation is not required by the State, the interim order of this Court dated 28.05.2021, granting ad interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner is made absolute.
