Prayer in the instant petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, is for issuance of directions to the official respondents to provide protection of life and liberty to the petitioners at the hands of private respondents No.5 to 7.

At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners would be satisfied if a direction is issued to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Moga, Punjab to look into their representation/complaint dated 28.03.2021 (Annexure P-2) which was sent to the office of respondent No.2 by hand.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits despite the fact that the private respondents had been indulging in unruly behaviour and trying to dispossess the petitioners from their house by threatening them and also indulging in assault as many as on three occasions, the authorities concerned have been sitting over the matter.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Luvinder Sofat, Assistant Advocate

General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents-State.

Keeping in view the submissions made by the learned counsel for the petitioners, respondent No.2- Senior Superintendent of Police, Moga, Punjab is directed to look into the representation/complaint dated 28.03.2021 (Annexure P-2) of the petitioners *qua* the threat perception and take appropriate steps/action, if any required under the provisions of law, at the earliest.

The petition is disposed of accordingly.
