The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for the grant of regular bail in FIR No. 153 dated 01.04.2017 registered under Section 346 IPC (Sections 364, 302, 201, 120-B & 34 IPC added subsequently) at Police Station Sadar Fatehabad, district Fatehabad.

Since in the petitioner's trial 38 out of total 42 prosecution witnesses already stand examined, learned counsel for the petitioner, at the fag end of the petitioner's trial, does not press the present petition. However, he prays for the petitioner's trial's expeditious disposal.

Dismissed as not pressed with a direction to the Trial Court to dispose of the petitioner's trial expeditiously but not without granting adequate opportunity to her to lead her defence evidence, if any.
