AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

The matter is taken up for hearing through video conference due to COVID-19 situation.

This petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is filed seeking directions to the official respondents to conduct fair and impartial investigation in FIR No. 422 dated 18.12.2020, under Sections 406, 420, 506, 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Civil Lines, Sirsa.

On the last date, learned counsel for the State on instructions submitted that out of six accused, two have been arrested and challan presented.

Today, learned counsel for the State submits that sincere effort is being made to apprehend the remaining four accused.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, however, submits that the FIR is of December, 2020, yet there is no considerable progress.

It is not a case where the investigation in the FIR is not proceeding. Two accused have been arrested and challan presented. The petitioner has an effective alternative remedy as per the provisions of Cr.P.C.

Without making any further observation, the present petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to avail remedies in accordance with law.
