The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.211 dated 19.06.2018 under Sections 363, 366A IPC, registered at Police Station Sahnewal, District Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the present case and on the direction of this Court, has joined the investigation. It is also contended that nothing is to be recovered from him.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Harpal Singh, would submit that petitioner has joined the investigation and that the matter has been investigated and challan has been presented in the Court.

In view of the facts that the matter has been investigated and petitioner has joined the investigation, without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and order dated 18.03.2020 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 (2) Cr. P.C.
