The hearing of the case was held through video conferencing on account of restricted functioning of the Courts.

Through this petition filed by as many as 29 petitioners pray for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to release the payment in terms of judgment dated 18.09.2018 passed by the High Court.

The land belonging to the petitioners was the subject matter of acquisition vide an award dated 27.12.2006. Initially, the Haryana State Industrial & Infrastructure Development Corporation Ltd. entered into a joint

venture with M/s Reliance Haryana Sez Ltd. for developing the land. The

Government also took a conscious decision to provide employment to one member of the family of the owners who stood deprived of the land. However, the venture in collaboration of Reliance did not take off and now, the State seeks to develop the area as Global City Project.

The petitioners filed CWP No.15961 and 5232 of 2015 seeking employment in terms of the policy decision. In the aforesaid writ petitions, an affidavit was filed on behalf of the State undertaking to pay compensation in lieu of employment to the petitioners.

Through this petition, the petitioners complain that the payment, as undertaken, has not been released.

Sh. Ankur Mittal, Additional Advocate General, Haryana, on instructions from Mr. Manoj Pal Singh, GM (Estate), HSIIDC, Panchkula, Haryana, has submitted that a decision in this regard has already been taken and the payment in terms of the affidavit dated 10.12.2016 shall be released within a period of 15 days from today.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, no further order is required to be passed. However, the Haryana State Industrial & Infrastructure Development Corporation Ltd. shall remain bound by the statement given by its counsel.

Disposed of.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also

disposed of.
