The petitioner has approached this Court directly after his complaint was dismissed under Section 203 of the Cr.P.C., and such order has not been challenged in Revision under Section 379 before the competent Sessions Court. Therefore, this case is relegated to the Court of Sessions to pursue his remedy accordingly.

In the interest of justice, however, the petitioner is granted time of fifteen days from today to file his revisional application. If the same is done, the revisional application/petition shall be considered by the Ld. Sessions Court on merits and shall not be outrightly dismissed on account of any defect of limitation.

The present petition is disposed off with the above directions.
