This criminal writ petition has been filed under Article 226 Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus for directing respondent Nos.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners, who are apprehending threats at the hands of respondent Nos.4 to 8.

On 13.03.2020, the following order was passed by this Court:

“Ms. Monika Jalota, DAG, Punjab is directed to find out the existence of alleged threat. Counsel for the petitioners undertakes to supply three sets of paper book to the learned State counsel, during the course of the day.”

Today learned State counsel has produced the statement of petitioner No.1-Sahani Pravin, wherein she stated that her parents have accepted the alliance and as on today, she and her husband (petitioner No.2) are not facing any threat and do not need any protection.

In view of the above, the petition is rendered infructuous.

Dismissed as infructuous.
