The petitioner in the present writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeks consideration of representations dated 13.11.2020 and 17.02.2021 (Annexures P-3 & P-4), on account of the fact he is owner in possession of 6 biswas, on the basis of a sale deed dated 25.09.2003 (Annexure P-1).

It is the grouse of the petitioner that he is being asked to vacate the possession by the Market Committee Bhadson-respondent No.5, from the house which has been constructed on the said land by taking loan. It is submitted that various representations have been made to official respondents regarding the grouse as such.

The above facts would go on to show that the petitioner is stated to be owner in possession, on the basis of a sale deed. If he wants to protect his possession on the said land, he can always approach the Civil Court of competent jurisdiction for the necessary relief. No case as such is made out to decide the representations regarding the above grouse.

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Accordingly, the present writ petition is disposed of with the
aforesaid liberty in accordance with law.
