1. This petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of Constitution of India for issuance a writ in the nature of certiorari quashing the impugned possession notice dated 26.6.2020 (P/4) issued by the respondent under Section 13 (4) of the Securitization and Reconstruction of Financial Assets and Enforcement of Security Interest Act, 2002 read with Rule 8 (1) of the Security Interest (Enforcement) Rules, 2002 and permit the petitioners to redeem the residency property.

2. The primary grievance raised by the learned counsel for the petitioner in this writ petition is that application for interim relief was filed before DRT but the same has not been taken up for hearing because of the fact that charge of DRT-III is given to the DRT-I Bangluru who holds the Court only on Tuesday and Thursday and the case has now been adjourned to 24.5.2021(Monday) on which date the DRT-1 is not going to hold the Court.

3. In the circumstances, we deem it appropriate to dispose of this writ petition with a direction to the DRT-I to adjourn the case on 25.5.2021 after giving notice to other side and take up and decide the application filed by the petitioner on that date.

4. Petition stands disposed of with above-said directions.

5. Since the main petition has been decided, the pending application, if any, also stands disposed of.
