The hearing of the case was held through video conferencing on account of restricted functioning of the Courts.

The petitioner herein is the plaintiff in a pending suit. An application filed by the petitioner for grant of an injunction, from interfering in her possession was allowed. The first appellate Court has reversed the same. Consequently, the injunction order granted in favour of the petitioner stands vacated, vide an order dated 01.08.2018.

The learned counsel representing the petitioner does not dispute that the petitioner's mother and sister filed a suit and the question of validity of the Will was finally decided by the Supreme Court. He claims that such a finding is only incidental. It is also not in dispute that the suit filed by the petitioner has now come up at the stage of rebuttal evidence and final arguments. Moreover, the petitioner has failed to '*prima-facie*' prove her possession.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, no ground to interfere in the impugned order, is made out.

Dismissed.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
