The hearing of the case was held through video conferencing on account of restricted functioning of the Courts.

Through this writ petition, the petitioner (widow of Sh. Baldev Raj who was working as a Lineman) prays for issuance of direction to the respondents to release the amount of gratuity, leave encashment, GIS and family pension. It is the case of the petitioner that her husband died while on duty on 01.01.2021 due to electric shock.

Sh. Abhilaksh Grover, Advocate, enters appearance for respondent-corporation and states that the request of the petitioner is under active consideration and most likely the amount shall be released within a period of four weeks.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, the writ petition is disposed of by directing the respondents to release the amount legally due to her within a period of four weeks from today. If the amount due is not released, the salary of the Chairman-cum-Managing Director and all Directors of the Corporation shall not be disbursed till the payment is released to the widow.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also

disposed of.
