Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking quashing of FIR No.168 dated 24.09.2015, registered for offences under Sections 341, 323, 506 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, at Police Station, Sector 3 (North), Chandigarh along with all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise dated 08.03.2021 (Annexure P-2).

During the course of hearing, it has been transpired that the petitioner was declared as proclaimed offender, which order he has challenged before this Court by filing CRM-M-40151-2018. As this fact has not been mentioned in the present petition, counsel for the petitioner seeks and is granted permission to withdraw the petition with liberty to file a fresh one with better particulars.
