The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.1187 dated 11.12.2019 under Section 376 of the IPC registered at Police Station Gurgaon Sadar, District Gurugram.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to order dated 18th March 2020 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined investigation. It is the case of the petitioner that the complainant was a consenting party and thereafter she had been black-mailing the petitioner to extort money from him. It was brought to the notice of the Court that there

were two audio recordings between the complainant and family of the petitioner, which clinchingly revealed that the FIR in question had been registered by the complainant only to extort money.

Learned State counsel on instructions from LSI Mukesh states that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no longer required for further interrogation.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and interim order dated 18th March 2020 is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) CrPC.
