The case has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.05 dated 04.01.2021 registered under Section 11 of Animal Cruelty Act and under Sections 13(1), 13(2) and 17(1) of Haryana Gauvansh Sanrakshan and Gausamvardhan Act, at Police Station Bhuna, District Fatehabad

As per allegations in the FIR 14 animals were recovered from a truck belonging to the petitioner. Driver of the truck i.e. Gurpyar Singh and one Baldev Singh were found in the truck. Petitioner being registered owner of the truck is prima facie responsible for the transportation of 14 cattles which were being taken for slaughtering to Uttar Pradesh. Ashok Nayak and Ramesh are still at large who were piloting the said truck.

In my considered opinion, no ground is made out to

grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw this petition.
