Present:- Mr. H.P.S. Rahi, Advocate, for the applicant.

It is submitted that finding given in para No.16 of judgment dated 14.02.2020 is erroneous and thus, the judgment requires to be reviewed. Moreover, the name of minor child has been mentioned in cause title of the judgment. Thus, there is error apparent on the record necessitating filing of review petition.

The arguments raised are totally mis-conceived. The findings in paragraph No.16 of the judgment are on merits of the case and if, the applicant feels that they are erroneous, he has the liberty of challenging the same. An erroneous finding is not an error apparent on the face of the record entitling the applicant to file a review petition. Regarding the name of the minor having been mentioned on the cause title of the judgment, the minor himself has filed CWP-38098-2018 and thus, his name has to appear in the cause title.

In view of the above, the review application cannot be entertained. It is accordingly, dismissed.
