This is 2nd petition for grant of regular bail in FIR No.114 dated 08.08.2020 under Sections 22/25 of Arms Act, registered at Police Station Tappa Mandi, District Barnala; earlier one was dismissed on 23.02.2021.

The only ground taken in the present petition is that one of the co-accused Gurdeep Singh has been granted the concession of regular bail vide order dated 18.03.2021 passed in CRM-M-40320-2020.

A perusal of the order dated 18.03.2021 shows that co-accused Gurdeep Singh has been granted bail on compassionate ground that he is aged about 72 years.

Learned State counsel has, however, submitted that as per allegations in the FIR, the petitioner along with co-accused was apprehended

and 3500 intoxicant tablets were recovered. It is further submitted that the petitioner was named in the secret information, which was followed by recovery from him.

In view of the above, I find no ground to entertain this second petition for grant of regular bail to the petitioner.

Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed.
