The hearing of the case was held through video conferencing on account of restricted functioning of the Courts.

This petition has been filed by the petitioner (wife) seeking the transfer of the petition filed under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, bearing No.DMC/216/2020, titled as 'Kanwajeet Singh vs. Jasleen Kaur' pending in the Court of Principal District Judge, Family Court, Ferozepur to the Court of competent jurisdiction at Faridkot.

The petitioner claims that she got married to the respondent on 01.04.2017. She claims that, at present, she is residing with her parents at Faridkot and the distance between Ferozepur and Faridkot is 50 kms and she does not have any independent source of income. It has also been brought to the notice of the Court that the respondent is already facing trial in a petition filed under Section 125 Cr.P.C at District Court, Faridkot.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, the transfer application is allowed. It is directed that the file of the petition filed under Section

13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, bearing No.DMC/216/2020, titled as 'Kanwajeet Singh vs. Jasleen Kaur' pending in the Court of Principal District Judge, Family Court, Ferozepur be transferred to the Court of competent jurisdiction at Faridkot. The transferor court is directed to remit the file of the case to the transferee court forthwith. The parties through their counsel are directed to appear before the District & Sessions Judge, Faridkot on 17.09.2021, who would either try the case himself or assign the same to the court of competent jurisdiction in the District.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
