Petitioners have filed this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of complaint bearing case No. 122 dated 07.04.2017, under Sections 380, 457, 427, 506 IPC (P-1), pending before learned Judicial Magistrate First Class, Jalandhar as well as the summoning order dated 06.06.2019 (P-2) whereby petitioners have been summoned to face trial under Sections 380, 451, 427 and 506 IPC and other consequential proceedings arising therefrom qua petitioners on the basis of compromise.

Vide order dated 05.07.2021, notice of motion was issued and the parties were directed to appear before concerned Trial Court/Illaq Magistrate on 05.08.2021 for getting their statements and the Trial Court was to send its report regarding the genuineness of the compromise.

A report dated 22.09.2021 of learned Judicial Magistrate First Class, Jalandhar has been received. As per the report, the parties had appeared before learned Judicial Magistrate First Class, Jalandhar and got recorded their statements regarding compromise. Learned Magistrate has stated that the compromise is genuine, voluntary and without any coercion or undue influence.

In view thereof, the present petition is allowed. Complaint bearing case No. 122 dated 07.04.2017, under Sections 380, 457, 427, 506 IPC (P-1), pending before learned Judicial Magistrate First Class, Jalandhar , along with all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, are hereby quashed, qua the petitioners.
