Prayer in this petition is to transfer the investigation of FIR No.124 dated 07.12.2019 under Sections 307, 323, 506, 341, 148, 149 IPC, Section 25 of the Arms Act Police Station Sandaur, District Sangrur, to some other independent agency.

Counsel for the State, on the basis of the affidavit of the Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub-Division Malerkotla, submits that respondents No.8 to 12, during the investigation, were found innocent and while conducting the investigation, some of the accused were arrested and released on bail. It is further stated that during the investigation, in the cross-version, Sections 307/148/149 IPC and 25/54/59 of the Arms Act were deleted and Sections 308/325/34 IPC in the main case and Section 325 IPC in the cross-version, were added. Similarly, Section 307 IPC is also deleted in the cross-version.

In view of the same, counsel for the petitioner submits that this petition may be disposed of granting liberty to the petitioner to avail his alternative remedy, before the Illaqa Magistrate.

Disposed of accordingly with liberty aforesaid.
