The present petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus for directing the respondents to decide the legal notice dated 08.11.2019 (Annexure P-1) to consider the case of the petitioner for appointment on compassionate grounds.

At the outset, counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner would be satisfied if the respondents pass a speaking order on legal notice dated 08.11.2019 (Annexure P-1) of the petitioner, within a time frame.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Akshay Jain, Advocate, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents. Even counsel for the respondents is not averse to the expeditious disposal of the claim of the petitioner.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.1 to decide the legal notice issued by the petitioner dated 08.11.2019 (Annexure P-1) and take a conscious decision thereon by passing a speaking order, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order.

It is further ordered that if the petitioner is found entitled to any pecuniary benefits upon such a conscious decision; then the said pecuniary benefits shall also be released to the petitioner within a further period of three months; from the date of such conscious decision of the authorities.
