The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for the grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.242 dated 24.10.2020 registered under Sections 307, 324, 326, 323, 148, 149 at Police Station City 1 Abohar, District Fazilka.

The petitioner had earlier approached this Court for the same relief as claimed through the instant petition through CRM-M-5419-2021- Sehajpreet Singh vs. State of Punjab which petition of his was dismissed as withdrawn on 05.02.2020 through the following order:-

“The arguments raised on behalf of the petitioner having not received a favourable response from the Bench and not to invite a decision on merits lest it may prejudice the case of the petitioner at a later stage, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks to withdraw the present petition.

Permitted to do so.

Dismissed as withdrawn.”

It is not disputed that there is no change in circumstance after the passing of the afore quoted order.

In view of the above there is no justifiable reason to grant to the petitioner the relief sought through the present petition.
