This is a petition for regular bail filed on behalf of the petitioner under Section 439 Cr.P.C. in case FIR No.250 dated 21.12.2020, under Sections 379-B & 411 of the IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, registered at Police Station Mahilpur, District Hoshiarpur

[2]. Seen Custody Certificate of the petitioner, who is a woman, from which it transpires that she has by now remained in detention in the present case for a period of 3 months and 21 days.

[3]. After completion of investigation, Challan against the petitioner has already been submitted and Charges have also been framed, but the prosecution evidence is yet to commence.

[4]. In these circumstances, without commenting any further on the merits of the present case as a whole, but in view of the detention undergone by the petitioner and the fact that the trial is likely to take its own considerable time due to ongoing Covid-19 Pandemic, as such, the prayer of

the petitioner for regular bail is allowed and he is ordered to be released on bail subject to appropriate terms and conditions to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court/Duty Magistrate, concerned.
