Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioner, the petition is disposed of with a direction that in case the petitioner moves an application under Section 156(3) Cr.P.C. before the Illaqa Magistrate, the Illaqa Magistrate shall endeavour to dispose of the same expeditiously in accordance with law and shall take all such necessary steps as may be warranted under law.

It is further ordered that respondent No.3 - Senior Superintendent of Police, Kapurthala, Punjab shall get the representation dated 07.01.2021 (Annexure P-3) examined qua the alleged threat perception to the petitioner and in case it is found that there is any genuine threat to life and liberty of the petitioner then necessary steps as warranted under law be taken thereupon at the earliest.

A copy of this order alongwith representation dated 07.01.2021 (Annexure P-3) be sent to respondent No.3 - Senior Superintendent of Police, Kapurthala, Punjab for necessary compliance.
