Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that the petitioner is working with the respondents since 02.02.1993 and from the year 1996, the work being done by the petitioner is of regular in nature and is without any break and hence, the petitioner is entitled for regularization of his service. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the policy, which has been issued by the respondent-State dated 29.07.2011 (Annexure P-2) squarely covers the case of the petitioner for the regularization of his service.

The prayer of the petitioner is for issuance of appropriate direction to the respondents to consider the claim of the petitioner for regularization of his service as per the policy dated 29.07.2011 (Annexure P-2).

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that for the relief which has been claimed in the present writ petition, the petitioner has

already served a legal notice on 19.12.2019 (Annexure P-4), which is still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a time bound direction is issued to respondent No.3 to decide the said legal notice by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Notice of motion.

Ms. Rajni Gupta, learned Additional Advocate General, Haryana, who has joined the proceedings through video conference, keeping in view the service of advance copy of petition, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and raises no objection for deciding the legal notice of the petitioner in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case or about the entitlement of the petitioner for the relief which has been claimed by him in the legal notice dated 19.12.2019 (Annexure P-4), the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 to decide the legal notice dated 19.12.2019 (Annexure P-4) within a period of three months from the receipt of copy of this order.
