This is a petition that has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner, pending trial, in case FIR No.154, dated 18.11.2020, registered under Section 379 IPC at Police Station Alewa, District Jind.

Learned counsel for the petitioner herein would contend that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the instant case. Petitioner is in custody since 05.02.2021. Investigation is complete, challan stands presented and charges have been framed. The trial in the case will take some time to conclude.

On the other hand, learned State counsel opposes the grant of regular bail, however, is not in a position to dispute the fact that challan stands presented and charges have been framed.

After having heard learned counsel for the parties and keeping in view the fact that the petitioner is in custody since 05.02.2021, investigation is complete, challan stands presented, charges have been framed and the trial in the case will take time to conclude, this Court deems it appropriate to release the petitioner on regular bail.

Accordingly, the instant petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail on execution of adequate personal bond and surety bond to the satisfaction of concerned trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

However, any observation made herein shall not be construed to be an expression of opinion on merits of the case.
