The matter is taken up for hearing through video conference due to COVID-19 situation.

This petition is filed for grant of anticipatory bail in case of FIR No. 146 dated 12.4.2016, under Sections 306 read with Section 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Badshahpur, District Gurugram Haryana.

The petitioner was summoned under Section 319 Cr.P.C. and hence the present petition was filed.

On 17.3.2020, the Court considering the fact that earlier the petitioner was found innocent but later was summoned during trial by issuing arrest warrant vide order dated 2.3.2020, issued notice of motion and granted interim bail. The petitioner was directed to appear before the trial Court on the date fixed and on his appearance, he was to be admitted on interim regular bail subject to furnishing of surety bonds.

Learned State counsel on instructions from SI Harkesh Singh submits that the petitioner appeared before the trial Court and submitted surety bonds.

In view of above fact, the interim bail granted on 17.3.2020 is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall continue to appear before the trial Court as and when required.

Disposed of accordingly.
