It is stated that petitioner No.1 – Priya, aged about 24 years has got married with petitioner No.2 – Ajay Pal Singh Randhawa, aged about 23 years against wishes of her family members, arrayed as respondents No.4 to 7, who are threatening to interfere in their marital life, as such to seek protection in that regard, they have approached this Court by way of filing the present petition.

It is further stated that the petitioner No.1 had submitted a written representation to respondent No.2 – Senior Superintendent of Police, Batala dated 14.3.2020 seeking protection, copy of the same being Annexure P5 without evoking any response so far.

Notice of motion to respondent -State.

Mr.J.S. Ghuman, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3.

The petition is disposed of directing respondent No.2 – Senior Superintendent of Police, Batala, District Batala to look into the representation Annexure P5, assess threat perception to the petitioners and if he finds that some action in the matter is warranted, then the needful be done in accordance with law.

However, this order shall not validate the marriage between the petitioners and shall not have any effect on any civil or criminal action to which the petitioners may be found liable, under the law.
