On the asking of the Court, Mr. Kiran Pal Singh, AAG,
Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the
respondents and raises no objection to the prayer made in the application.

For the reasons mentioned in the application and with the
consent of both sides, the application is allowed. Main case is preponed
from 01.04.2022 and taken on Board today itself.

Main case

Writ petition under Article 226 of the Constitution has been

filed, *inter alia*, for quashing of notice/communication bearing No.861/W-5 dated 13.01.2021 (P-9), whereby, claim of the petitioner for compassionate appointment on account of death of his father was declined.

Learned counsel, on instructions from the petitioner, states that at this stage, instead of pressing the petition on merits, his client would be satisfied, in case, representation dated 27.07.2020 (P-5), already pending with the respondents, is decided expeditiously.

Learned State counsel raises no objection against the above innocuous prayer made on behalf of the petitioner.

In view of the agreed stand taken by both sides, but without going into the merits of the controversy, this writ petition is disposed off with direction to the respondents, to consider and decide the aforesaid representation dated 27.07.2020 (P-5), by passing speaking order in accordance with law, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
