HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI, J.(ORAL)

Present petition has been filed seeking the release of the payment for which the petitioner is entitled in respect of the supply of the interlocking tiles for the development of the roads at Village Hariewala, Tehsil Bagha Purana, District Moga.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the interlocking tiles, the details of which have been given in paragraph 3 of the petition, have already been delivered but the full payment, for which the petitioner is entitled, is not being released to the petitioner and that too without any valid justification.

The prayer of the petitioner is for directing the respondents to release the full payment for which the petitioner is entitled, for supply of the interlocking tiles.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that for the relief which has been claimed in the present writ petition, the petitioner has

already submitted a representation dated 04.01.2021 (Annexure P-4) to the respondents, which is still pending consideration and the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a time bound direction is issued to respondent No.2 to decide the said representation by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Notice of motion.

Ms. Sunint Kaur, learned Assistant Advocate General, Punjab, who has joined the proceedings through video conference, keeping in view the service of advance copy of petition, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and raises no objection for deciding the representation of the petitioner in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case or about the entitlement of the petitioner for the relief which has been claimed by him in the representation dated 04.01.2021 (Annexure P-4), the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to decide the representation dated 04.01.2021 (Annexure P-4) within a period of three months from the receipt of copy of this order.
