LISA GILL, J.

This matter is being taken up for hearing through video conferencing due to outbreak of the pandemic, COVID-19.

Petitioner is stated to be a Government contractor and supplier. It is submitted that pursuant to successful completion of supply of interlocking tiles from October, 2018 to January, 2019, sum of Rs.4,63,304/- has not been released, despite there being no dispute regarding the same. It is categorically submitted that there is no dispute regarding this payment and work has been successfully completed to the satisfaction of the authorities.

Ms. Ambika Bedi, AAG, Punjab to whom advance copy of this writ petition has been supplied, at this stage, on instructions from Sh. Hardeep Sharma, Superintendent, BDPO office, Kot Ishe Khan, submits that payment due towards the petitioner shall be released within two weeks.

In view of the specific stand of respondents No. 1 and 2 as above, no further orders are called for in this case.

Present petition is accordingly disposed of. Needless to say, in case, requisite payment is not released to the petitioner within two weeks, he is at liberty to avail remedy/remedies as may be available to him.
