Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.10 dated 04.01.2016 registered under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471, 506 read with Section 120-B IPC at Police Station City Yamuna Nagar, District Yamuna Nagar.

Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the arrest of the petitioner was stayed on 19.03.2020. It is further submitted that the petitioner is not a beneficiary and the main accused Neelam Vinayak, and Gulshan Vinayak, have already been granted the concession of anticipatory bail vide order dated 09.07.2020 passed in CRM-M Nos.12023 and 12025 of 2020.

Counsel for the petitioner has further argued that as per the allegations in the FIR, the dispute arises out of an agreement to sell dated 19.11.2012 in which the co-accused were reflected as a purchaser. The allegations against the petitioner are that he has procured the signature of the seller on a blank paper. It is also submitted that it will

be a matter of trial whether the signatures were obtained by playing fraud or not as it has come in the report of FSL that the signatures on the agreement to sell have matched with the signatures of the seller. Lastly, it is submitted that in order to complete the investigation, the petitioner be directed to join the investigation.

Counsel for the State has not disputed the factual position but opposed the prayer for bail.

After hearing the counsel for the parties, considering the fact that the petitioner is not the beneficiary and the main accused Neelam Vinayak, and Gulshan Vinayak, have already been granted the concession of anticipatory bail, this petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to join investigation within a period of 10 days and he shall be released on interim bail subject to the following conditions:-

- 1. He shall make himself available for interrogation by a police officer as and when required;*
- 2. He shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer; and*
- 3. He shall not leave India without previous permission of the Court.*
