HARINDER SINGH SIDHU, J.

Present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C.
seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 09 dated 13.02.2017, under
Sections 498-A, 506 and 523 IPC registered at Women Police
Station, Fatehabad.

The FIR was registered against the petitioner by his wife.
In the said FIR, the petitioner was released on bail vide order dated
01.03.2017. Thereafter petitioner was regularly appearing before trial
Court. However, on 02.08.2019, the petitioner could not appear as he
was mentally upset on account of termination of his services. He had
informed his counsel telephonically to move an application seeking
exemption from personal appearance. But the counsel of the petitioner
did not file exemption application and on that day on account of non-
appearance of the petitioner his bail was cancelled and non-bailable
warrants were issued against the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the non appearance of the petitioner before the Court was not intentional. The petitioner undertakes to appear before the trial Court on any date to be fixed by this Court.

In view of the above, the petitioner may appear before the learned trial Court on or before 29.04.2021. On his doing so, he shall be enlarged on bail by the trial Court subject to his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to its satisfaction. This shall be subject to deposit of an amount of Rs.10,000/- by the petitioner with the Director PGIMER, Chandigarh Poor Patient Welfare Fund. He shall also file an undertaking before the trial Court to continue appearing as and when required apart from following all the terms and conditions fixed in this respect.
