Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.60 dated 08.02.2020 under Section 13(2) of Haryana Gauvansh Sanrakhshan and Samvardhan Act, 2015, Section 11 of Prevention of Cruelty to Animals Act, 1960 and Section 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Tauru, District Nuh.

While granting interim bail to the petitioner, following order was passed by this Court on 18.03.2020: -

“Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that as per allegations in the FIR, registered on the basis of a secret information, the police conducted a raid, however, the driver of the container, on seeing the police party, ran away and now the petitioner is being

involved as the said driver.

Learned counsel further submits that petitioner is not involved in any other such or similar case and he is ready to join investigation...”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance of the aforesaid order, the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for any further investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from HC Krishan, has not disputed the factual position and states that the petitioner is no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 18.03.2020 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
