The present writ petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking direction to the respondents for issuance of Non-Prohibited Bore (N.P.B.) Arm Licence to the petitioner which has not been issued even after passing of the stipulated time period.

The case of the petitioner is that he had applied for such licence on 31.05.2018 along with all requisite documents (Annexure P-1). The report had also been called for by respondent No.2 from respondent No.3 on 12.06.2018 (Annexure P-2) but in spite of that no action has been taken though considerable period has expired. It is submitted that representation dated 03.03.2020 (Annexure P-4) has also been served upon respondent No.2 but of no avail.

Notice of motion.

Mr. R.K.S. Brar, Additional AG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the State.

Keeping in view the above, application dated 31.05.2018 (Annexure P-1) submitted by the petitioner for the said arms licence be processed in accordance with law and under the provisions of the Arms Act, 1959 and rules framed thereunder. The final decision be conveyed to the petitioner expeditiously within a period of 3 months from the date of receipt of the certified copy of order. In case, licence is not liable to be issued, the said respondent shall give reasons for declining the said benefit to the petitioner.

Accordingly, the present writ petition is disposed of.
