Case is taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

This is a petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of directions to the official respondents to conduct a fair and impartial inquiry/investigation on the representation/complaint dated 08.3.2021 (Annexure P-1) made by the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the marriage of the petitioner and Amarjeet Singh-respondent No. 5 was solemnized on 4.10.2016 and it was a love marriage and out of the said wedlock, a girl child was born. He further submits that now respondent No. 5 has solemnized marriage with Baljeet Kaur-respondent No. 11 and the petitioner along with her minor daughter have been thrown out of the matrimonial home. He further submits that for redressal of her grievance, the petitioner has moved a representation dated 8.3.2021 (Annexure P-1) to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Fazilka, but no action has been taken on the accused persons.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Avtar Singh Sandhu, Addl. A.G.,
Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the State.

Keeping in view the above, the present petition is disposed of
with a direction to Senior Superintendent of Police, Fazilka-respondent
No. 2 to look into the representation of the petitioner dated 08.3.2021
(Anneuxre P-1) and decide the same within a period of one month from the
receipt of certified copy of this order, as per law.
